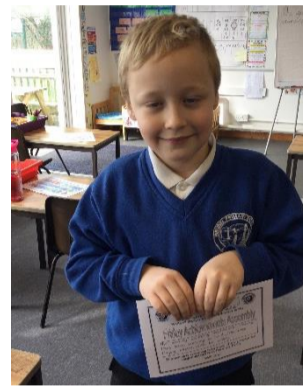
For his fantastic reading, his confidence is really growing.

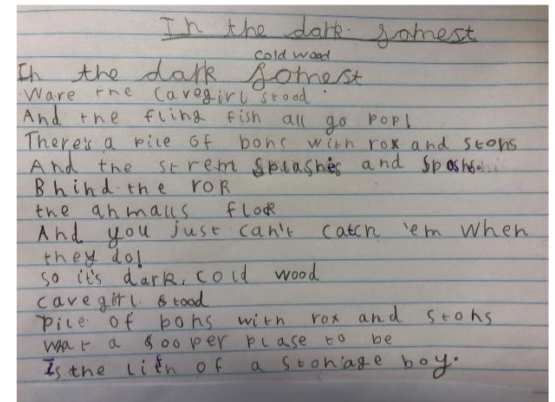
For settling so well back into the routines of school after lockdown and doing lots of brilliant learning this week.

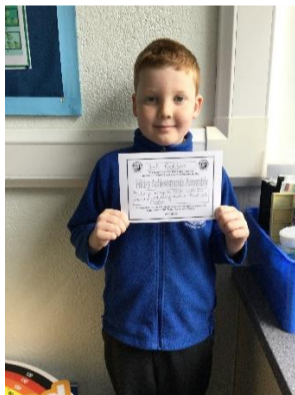
For his amazing sentences. He has worked so hard, like Keep Trying Kirsten, with his writing.

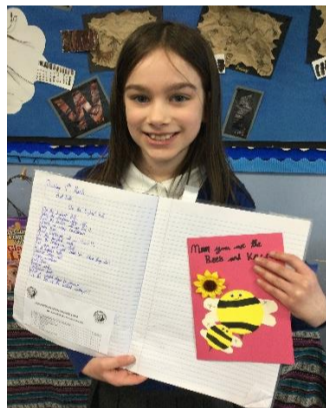
What a fantastic rhyming poem E has written! She included alliteration too, in her poem in the style of Spike Milligan's 'On the Ning Nang Nong'

Mousehole



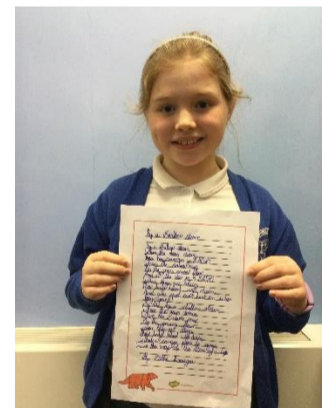
For always being on task with his learning and being such a 'Find Out Freddie'.

Whitsand



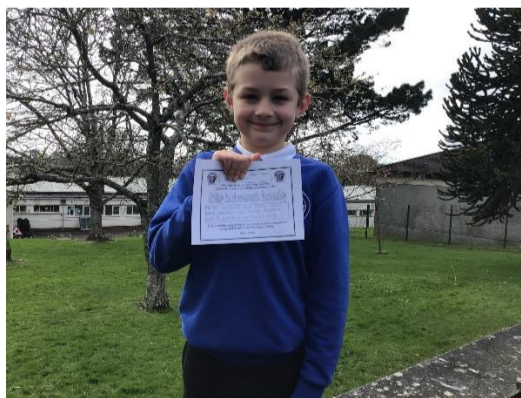
For independently writing a beautifully crafted Stone Age poem; she acted upon all our previous learning and applied it. Well done!
