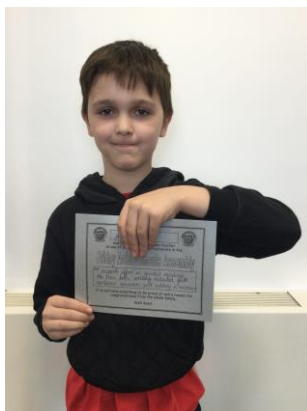
H for working extremely hard in all lessons and creating a fantastic piece of writing this week!

Mousehole



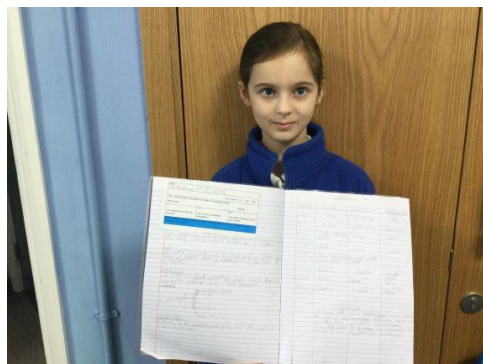

Whitsand



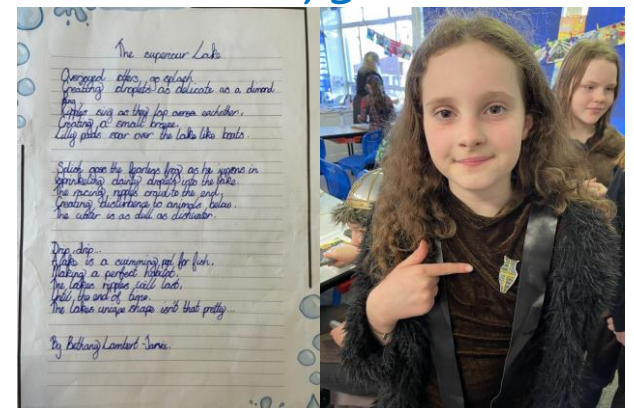
A has demonstrated superb effort in guided reading. He has been writing detailed, full sentence answers and adding in evidence. Well done!

Constantine



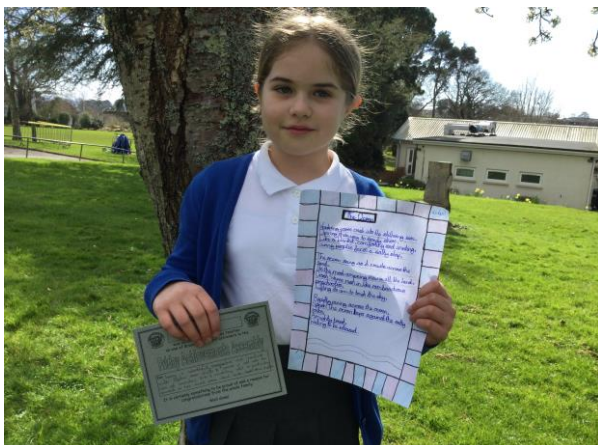
I is representing Constantine because she is working so incredibly hard, especially in reading and writing. She is a great example of 'Keep Trying Kirsten'.
