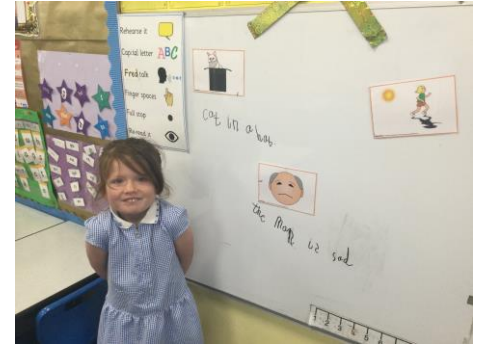


# Achievers

## Polzeath



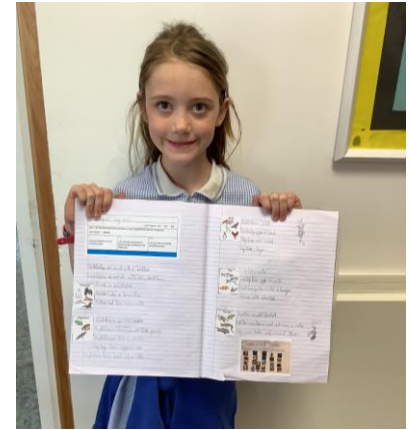
P has been a GREAT 'Have a go Harry' this week. Even when some work has been tricky P never gave up and kept trying! Well done!

## Whitsand



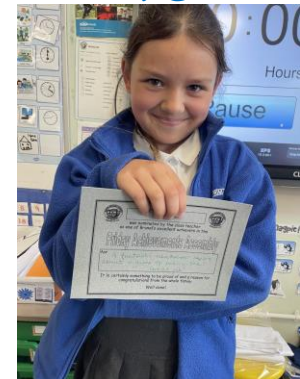
