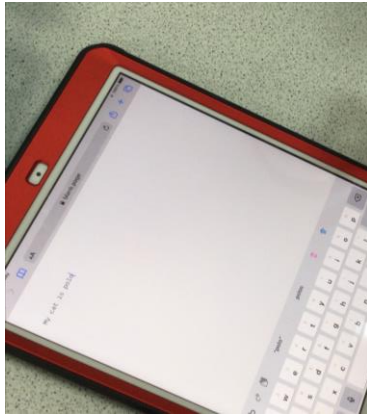

## Polzeath



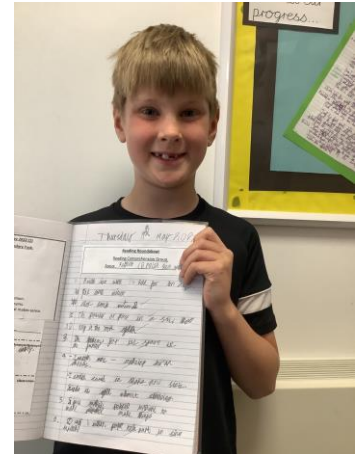
L has been a real Have a go Harry this week and has started **all** work with such enthusiasm – well done!

## Constantine



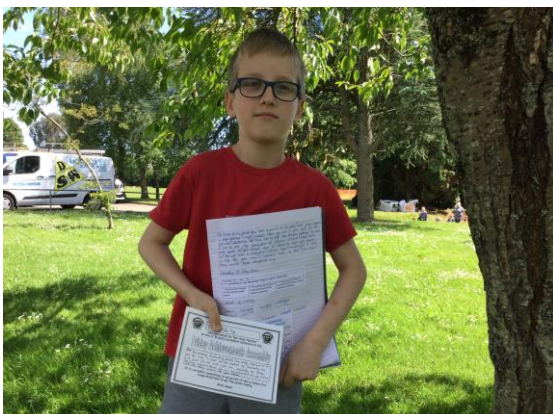
