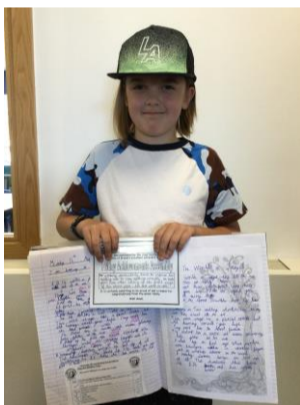


D has had a fantastic week and has been super keen to do well in all his learning. D has been showing great independence and wrote an amazing story independently -it is fab! Well done!

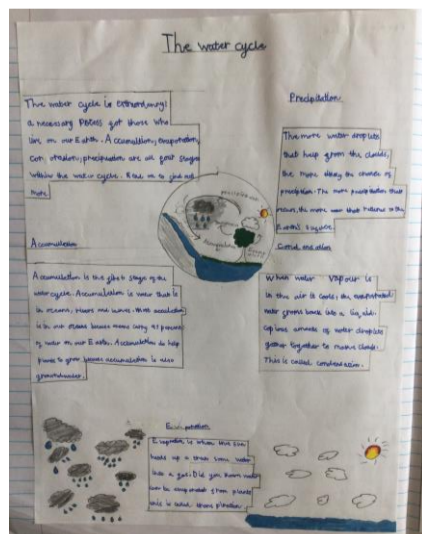

C has been working so hard towards his pen license, even practicing his writing at home. He finally got it this week and not only is he so proud of his work, we all are proud of his effort!

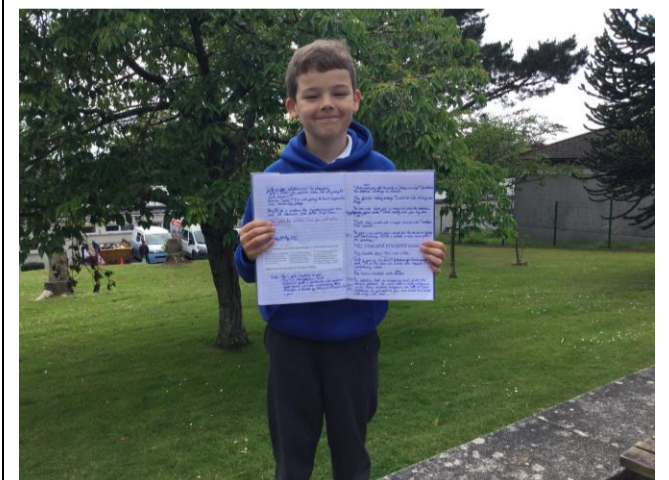
