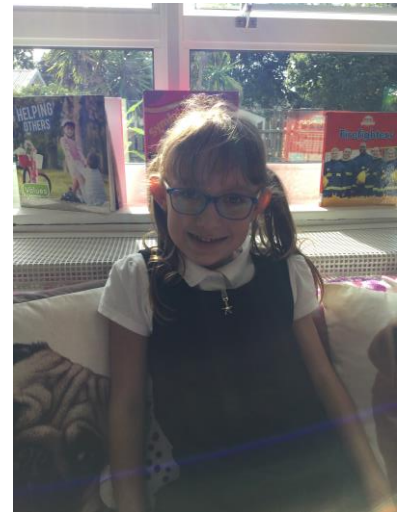

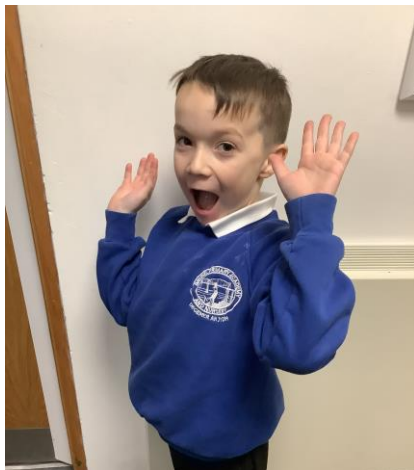


A is Portwrinkle's achiever this week. He is developing into a confident mathematician and already knows some number facts. Well done A!

P is Kingsand's achiever this week. She works hard in every lesson, but she has been a real 'Have a go Harry' during our English lessons this week. Great work P!!

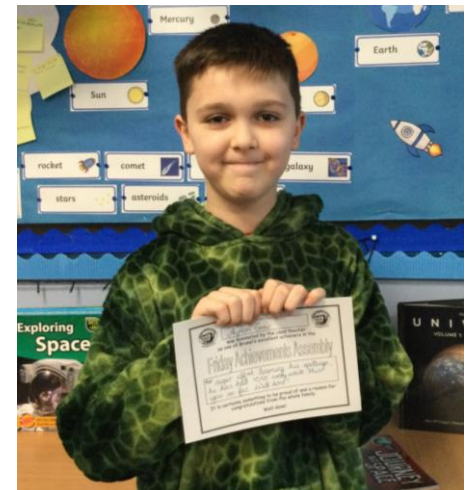

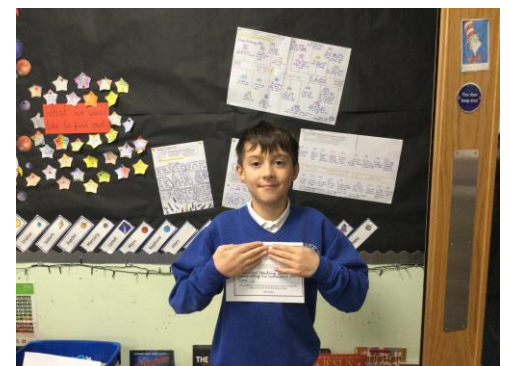
