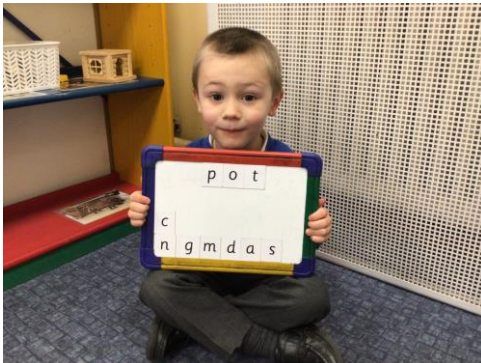


Achievers

Portwrinkle



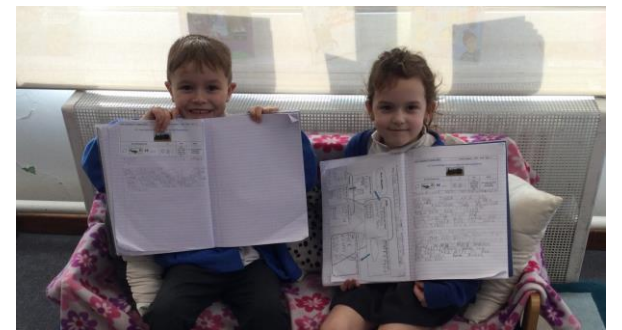
E is Portwrinkle's achiever this week. He has been like 'Have a Go Harry' in RWI, using Fred talk to make words independently during magnetic board time.

Kingsand



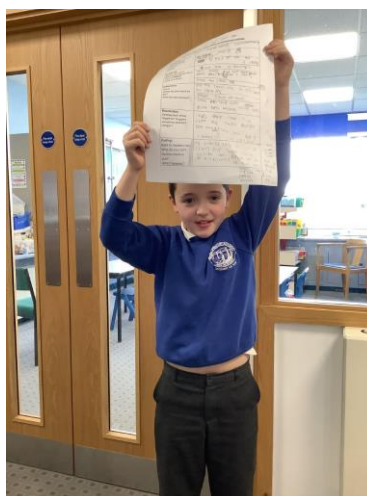

Mousehole



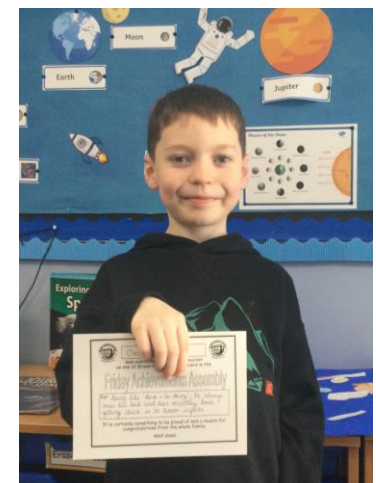
C has settled well into Mousehole class and Brunel school. He has embraced every new change with a smile and has joined in confidently and successfully across the curriculum.

Whitsand



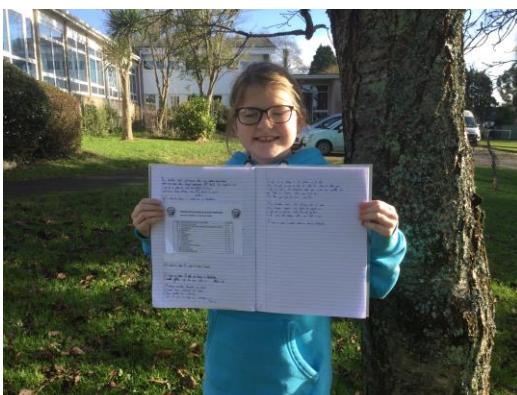

Talland



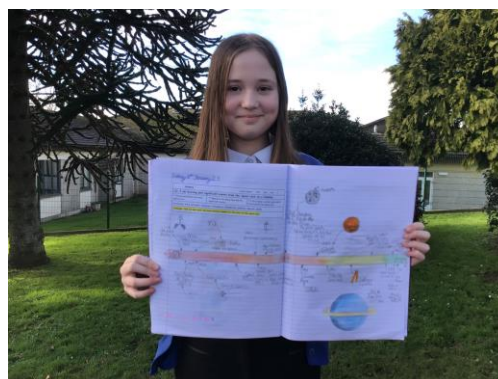
