## Portwrinkle



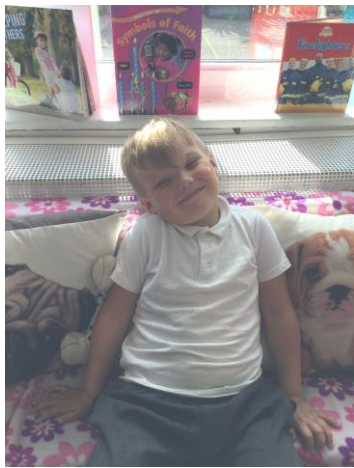

## Downderry



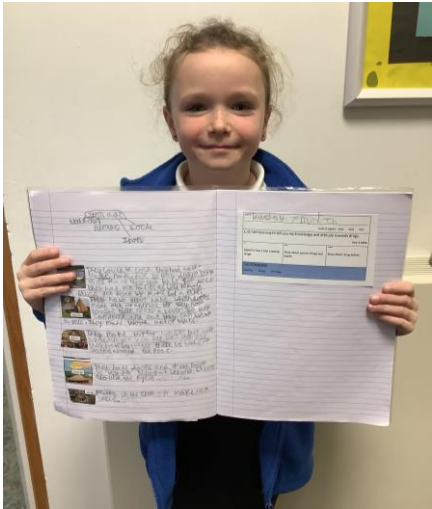

## Kingsand



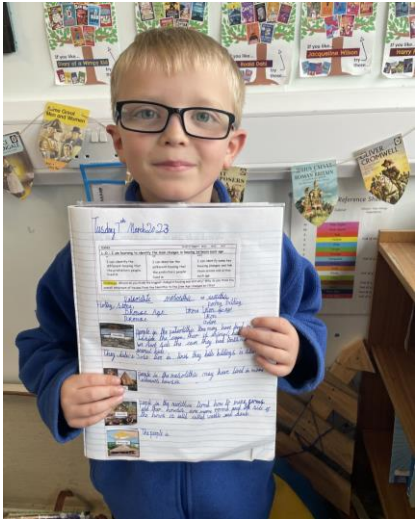

## Mousehole



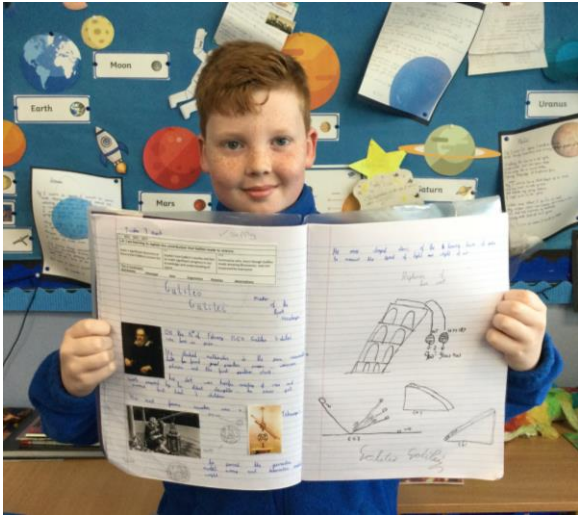

## Whitsand



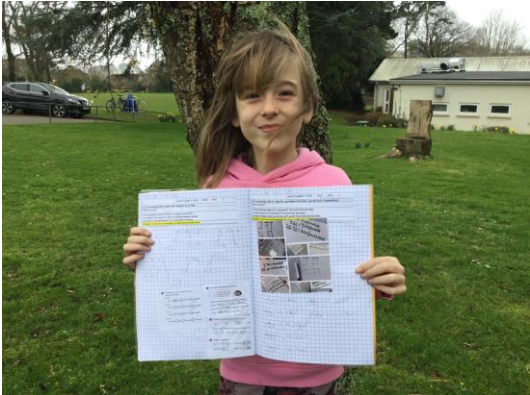

## Talland



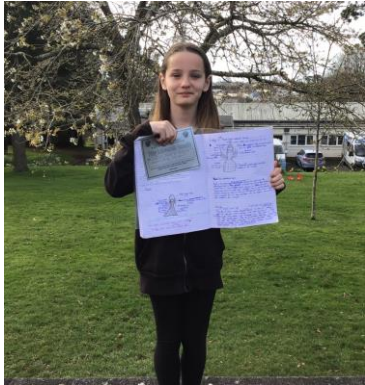
