Downderry



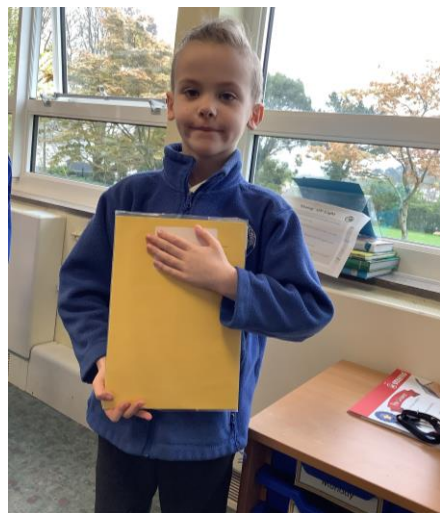

Kingsand



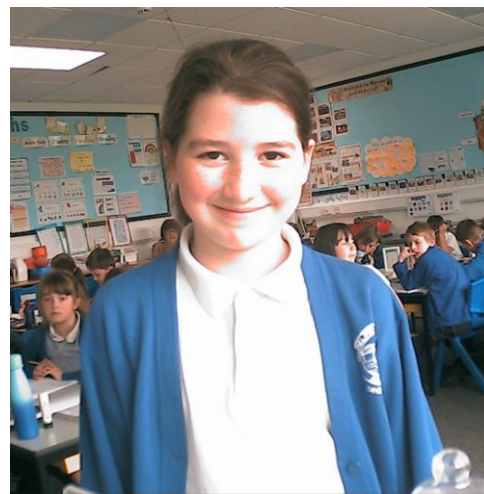

Mousehole



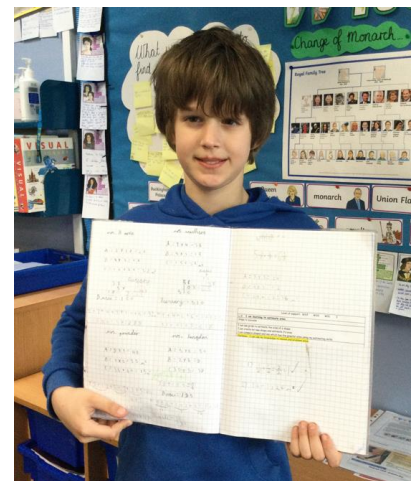

Whitsand



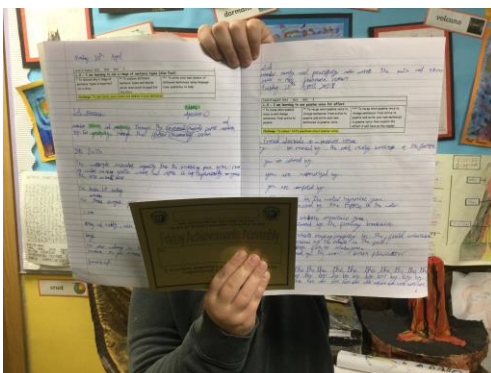
