Day	Phonics	Maths	For fun
<p>Monday</p> <p>Red ditty books can be found on Oxford Owl. Username: portwrinklebrunel and password: brunel.</p> <p>Click on Read Write Inc eBook library, Click on the drop down menu and select 'red phonics books'. You could try as a bridge between my sheets and the red books the 'red ditty book' selection. This is a collection of longer ditty sheets.</p>	<p>Anyone who is 100% confident with the special friends' sounds watch the Set 2 lesson with Rosie (ou as in shout it out)- she does go quite fast when reading the words so you may want to pause in between. You can go onto doing the spelling lesson with Rosie or follow your own using the Set 1&2 green words list. Everyone else watch the Set 1 sounds lesson followed by the set 1 word time/reading lesson (by Gareth). Following this Sarah does a Set 1 spelling lesson.</p> <p>Red ditty books-only the group who have read the ditty sheets. I have uploaded a video about how to read a red ditty book on the blog. I have uploaded 3 more ditties for any children who are not so confident. You do 1 story from the book each day. Remember we are going for fluency-reading with ease. If Your child struggles with the red ditty booksbthen carry on with the ditty sheets.</p> <p>I have uploaded a list of green words for extra spelling practice. Please encourage your child to use Fred fingers and Fred talk to spell these words-we don't write them for the children to copy. Do it exactly like Sarah/Rosie does in the lesson, you will see how much help your child will need.</p>	<p>Start off by flashing the numbers 1-20 out of order. Randomly stop on one number and ask what comes before or after that number.</p> <p>This week we are going to use natural items to arrange, compare and order.</p> <p>Today you could go on a 'Treasure hunt' to find some natural items. It could be in the garden, on a trip out or on the way to the shop. Remember to wash your hands afterwards.</p> <p>Can you find different leaves, twigs, pebbles, or shells? Or can you find some the same?</p>	<p>Go to CBeebies and download the storytime app. Here they have lots of interactive stories for you to listen to and read.</p> <p>Here's another treasure hunt for you-</p> <p>This one could be tricky! Can you find something that starts with every sound you know?</p> <p>Happy hunting-don't forget you can send me a photo of your treasure</p>

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<p>Tuesday</p>	<p>As Monday and read second story. Set 2 sound lesson 'oy'</p>	<p>Flash 1-20, then see how quickly you can put them in order.</p> <p>Today, can you make a pattern using the things you found yesterday? Look on Google for Andy Goldsworthy art.</p> 	<p>Go to Tapestry and listen to one of the stories the Portwrinkle staff have recorded</p> <p>Go to www.gonoodle.com and do one of their workouts</p> <p>Go for a walk.</p>
<p>Wednesday</p>	<p>You have come to the end of set 2 so you can either start again- Rosie will do 'ay' today, or you can just practice spelling words with the Set 2 sounds using the Set 2 green word list.</p>	<p>Using the items you found on your Treasure Hunt, can you arrange, compare and order them? Thursday	<p>As Wednesday Ask your children to write some sentences using te Set 2 sounds e.g. Play with a toy. Look at the snow. I can see a red cars I see the star at night. Use the set 1/2 word list to make up your own sentences. Use the words 'the/l/my/me/go' as they are good ones to learn but try to keep the other words decodable.</p>	<p>As Tuesday but once they have made their number line take away 2 or 3 numbers. Can they guess which ones are missing?</p> <p>Today you are going to compare your items using the vocabulary- longer, shorter, heavier, lighter. Can you order 3 of them? – The shortest to the longest. The lightest to the heaviest.</p>	<p>Go to Tapestry and listen to one of the Portwrinkle staff stories.</p> <p>Today is World Book Day so get a potato and dress it up as your favourite book character. Dress up and then take a photo of yourself of you and your potato. Post it on Tapestry and I'll try to guess who the characters are.</p> <p>In school I have signed up to 'How to draw with Nicola Slater' at 10 am so join us by registering with this link How to Draw with Nicola Slater Scholastic Live - Scholastic Shop</p>

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Friday	As Wednesday-make this a writing only day. Practise your speed sounds. Use the 'Speed sound patter' sheet to practise writing each letter correctly making sure you use the correct sequence. Write some set 1 speedy green words using the sheets but don't let your child copy the words, they must Fred talk them for themselves. Write a sentence about the story you liked the best this week. Set 2 sound 'ir'	Flash 1-20 Using the items you found on your Treasure Hunt can you make a collage picture with them using glue or tape? What describing words can you use to talk about your picture?	Go to CBeebies and download the storytime app. Here they have lots of interactive stories for you to listen to and read. Take a photo of your collage picture and upload it to Tapestry. .
